Ray Campbell
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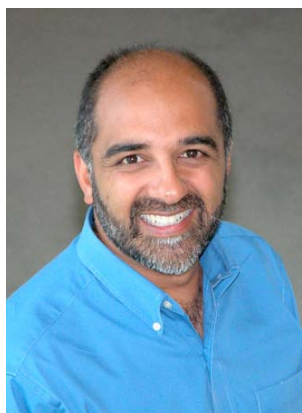
Ray Campbell is the Executive Director and Chief Executive Officer of the Massachusetts Health Data Consortium. Prior to MHDC he was a lawyer and consultant in private practice specializing in issues at the intersection of public policy, technology, and the law. Ray's public sector experience includes serving as the Executive Director of the Massachusetts Corporation for Educational Telecommunications, as the General Counsel of the Massachusetts Information Technology Division, and as the Director of Special Projects at the Massachusetts Executive Office for Administration and Finance. Ray was an attorney in private practice prior to entering the public sector and has a B.A. from Bates College, a J.D. from Suffolk University, and an M.P.A. from Harvard University.



Bethany M. Gilboard
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As Director of Health Technologies, Bethany is an integral team member of the Massachusetts e Health Institute (MeHI), established within the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative through Chapter 305 of the Acts of 2008. MeHI's mission is to promote implementation of Electronic Health Records

(EHR) in all provider settings as part of an interoperable Health Information Exchange. Bethany is also responsible for shaping e-health programs for the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative (MTC). In that capacity she directed the Massachusetts Hospital Computerized Physician Order Entry Initiative, a multimillion dollar, multi-year statewide program involving all Massachusetts hospitals, physician executives, legislative leaders, payers and employers. Since 1985, Bethany has worked both in the public and private health care sector and has extensive knowledge of both hospital and physician finances and operations. Immediately prior, to joining MTC, Bethany was Executive Director of a 280 member Physician Hospital Organization (PHO), which was one of the first independent PHO's in Massachusetts to move forward with EHR adoption. She has been credited with creating the foundation for an innovative financial incentive program to encourage adoption of EHRs and e-prescribing tools which led to an 80% adoption rate by primary care physicians in the PHO. Bethany has an undergraduate degree for the University of Rochester and a Masters of Public Administration, with a concentration in health policy and planning, from New York University Graduate School of Public Administration.



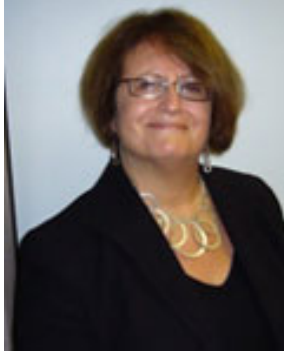
Micky Tripathi
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Micky Tripathi is the President and Chief Executive Officer of the Massachusetts eHealth Collaborative (MAeHC) and MAeHC Professional Services Corporation (PSC). He is also a member of the board of directors of MA-SHARE, a community utility service for state-wide clinical data exchange in Massachusetts.

Prior to joining MAeHC, Mr. Tripathi was a manager in the Boston office of the Boston Consulting Group, a leading strategy and management consulting firm. While at BCG, he served as the founding President and CEO of the Indiana Health Information Exchange, an Indianapolis-based non-profit company partnered with the Regenstrief Institute to create a state-wide health information infrastructure in the state of Indiana. As a manager in BCG's health care practice, Mr. Tripathi also served a variety of US and international clients in the non-profit sector as well as in the bioinformatics, biotechnology, and pharmaceutical industries.
